Energy Storage Summit Latin America 2025 took place on 14–15 October in Santiago, Chile, uniting the region's leading voices to explore how storage is driving system stability, deployment and new revenue opportunities across Latin America.

Over two days, developers, investors, utilities, manufacturers and policymakers shared practical insights on regulation, financing and technology shaping the market. From sessions on hybridisation and bankability to deep dives into policy and long-duration storage, the programme reflected the maturity and diversity of Latin America's energy transition.

Government leadership was front and centre, with Chile's Minister of Energy, Diego Pardow, and Argentina's Secretary of Energy, María Tettamanti, both addressing the Summit. CAMMESA and Chile's Comisión Nacional de Energía provided key updates on regulation and future tenders, underscoring the region's growing momentum.

The bilingual format welcomed delegates from across Chile, Peru, Brazil, Mexico, Colombia, Argentina and beyond, while Santiago proved once again the ideal host city and the perfect backdrop for shaping the next wave of storage deployment.

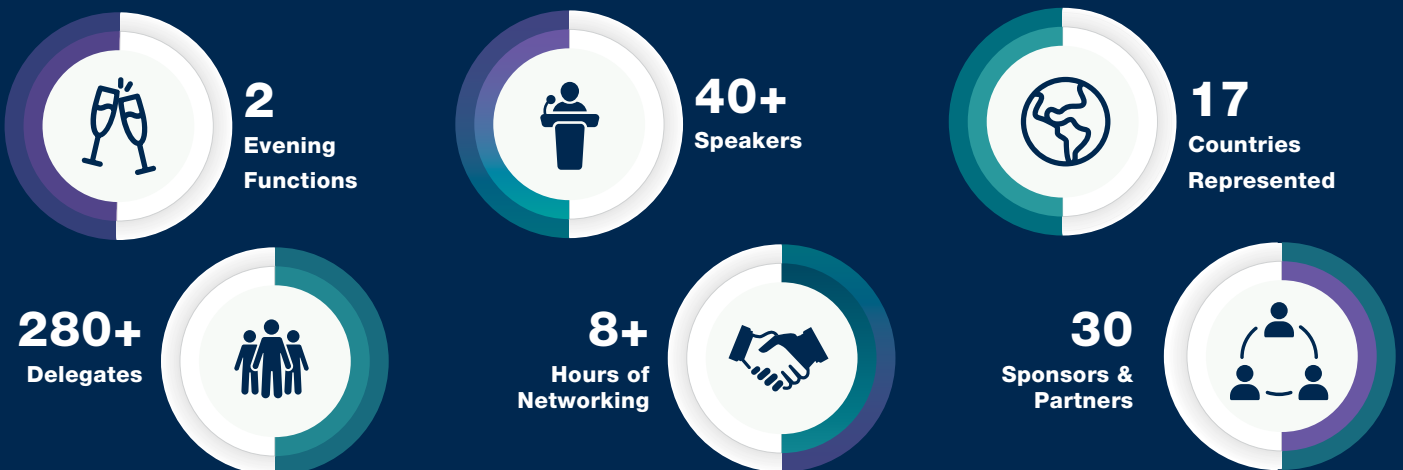

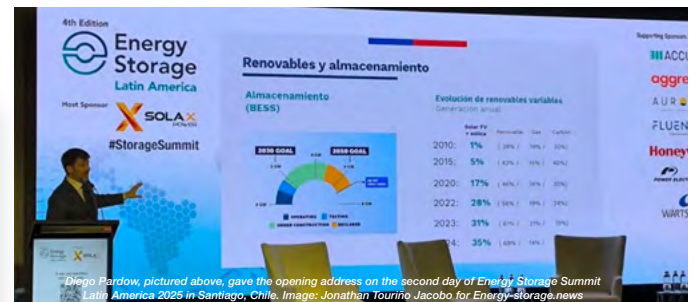
Chile to reach 2050 energy storage target within next two years, says energy minister

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During the opening address of Energy Storage Summit Latin America 2025, in Santiago, Chile, the Chilean Minister of Energy Diego Pardow Lorenzo said the country was most likely set to surpass its 2050 targets in 2027.

January, Chile will have installed 2GW of battery energy storage systems (BESS), which is set by 2030 for the country.

The minister added that there are 8GW under construction, 2GW more than the 2050 target.

The rapid expansion and construction of BESS projects in the country, one of the key elements of the energy transition's first day.

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
